Cumberland Primary and Specialist Schools SAM Network

A proposal to establish
a support network for
School Administrative Managers



Background

The Cumberland Primary and Specialist Schools incorporates 25 schools offering a wide range of educational environments and opportunities. They reflect and celebrate the social and cultural diversity of the Western Sydney Region.

There is a broad spectrum of education experiences within this group – from small schools; specialist schools - such as the Children's Hospital School; right through to Westmead Public School with its large enrolment base.

The group also incorporates learning communities and national partnership programs.

Benefits and Opportunities

The proposal to establish a SAM network for this group of schools reflects a desire to support our school communities in a complex education environment.

Administrative support in schools has undergone significant change over the last 20 years and school support staff have responded positively to these changes.

A Cumberland Primary and Specialist Schools SAM Network would focus on identifying challenges; creating solutions; and embracing reform.

These objectives would be achieved by establishing

- A sustainable support network for the promotion of *Best Practice*
- Access to a strong knowledge and experience base especially for newly appointed SAMs and SAMs in isolation
- Links with other SAM networks

Through collaboration and consultation, a Cumberland Primary and Specialist Schools SAM Network would explore themes such as

- Deployment of the LMBR and post-LMBR operations
- Technology and Innovation
- Mentoring and Professional Development opportunities
- School Development Days

The SAM Network would provide feedback to the Western Sydney Regional SASS Reference Group and support principals in decision making and planning.
